

Privacy Statement

Flowith Limited (hereafter to “we”, “us”, or “our”) is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Statement (hereafter to “Statement”) explains our core purposes for collecting and using your personal data. It also explains what your personal data rights are and how to contact us. It applies to everyone who may interact with us online and through our Photo Manager: Clean & Secure (hereafter to “App” or “Service”).

We recommend you read this Statement carefully before you download or enter into this App.

Part 1. Purpose of personal data processing

We process your personal data for the following purposes:

- To provide you with the App or Service.
- To monitor the quality of our Service.
- To communicate with you and answer your inquiries.
- To train and improve our apps or services and enhance the overall user experience.
- To ensure compliance with legal obligations.
- To solve disputes (if any), enforce our contractual agreements and establish, exercise or defend legal claims.

Part 2. Categories of personal data we processed

When visiting our App or using our Service, we may process the following categories of personal data:

- Your name and email address.
- IP addresses.
- Usage data includes the pages of our App you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers another diagnostic data.
- Device data includes device types and settings, device identifiers (such as IDFA, IDFV for Android, GAID for IOS), browser types, mobile, wireless, operating system versions, another network information (such as internet service provider name, carrier name and signal strength), and application version numbers.
- Activity data directly related to your use of the App, includes contact list and or photos.

Part 3. Sharing your personal data

Your data is only shared with those who need access to deliver and support the purposes described above, including the following:

- Our third-party suppliers, business partners and sub-contractors for business administration, support, processing, insurance, or IT purposes.
- Other companies within our group.
- Our professional advisors including external auditors who provide professional services to us and are bound by confidentiality obligations.
- Our regulators, law enforcement or fraud prevention agencies, as well as our legal advisers, courts, tribunals, the police and any other authorized bodies, for the purposes of investigating any actual or suspected criminal activity or other regulatory or legal matters

Part 4. Retention periods

Your personal data will be kept only as long as necessary for the purposes set out in this Statement. Unless indicated otherwise at the time of the collection of your personal data, we will delete or erase your personal data if the retention of that personal data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed, or to comply with legal obligations (such as retention obligations under tax or commercial laws).

Part 5. Your rights

Your personal data rights allow you to know about and take action relating to your personal data when it's held by organizations. The rights you may have including:

- The right to be informed. You have the right to know what personal data we hold about you and why and how we process it.
- The right of access. You have the right to ask us for a copy of the personal data we hold about you.
- The right of rectification. You have the right to ask us to correct or delete inaccurate personal data.
- The right of erasure. You have the right to ask us to delete personal data we're holding about you.
- The right to withdraw consent. At any time after providing consent for us to use your data, you may withdraw your consent.

Part 6. Security

We maintain appropriate technical and organizational safeguards against unauthorized processing of personal data and against accidental loss, destruction or damage. We also have procedures in place to deal with any data security breach. We will notify you and any applicable regulator of a data security breach where we are legally required to do so.

Part 7. Children

This App is not directed to children under the age of thirteen (13). We will not knowingly collect personal data from children under the age of thirteen (13) without prior parental consent if required by applicable law. We will only use or disclose personal data about a child to the extent permitted by law, to seek parental consent, pursuant to local law and regulations or to protect a child.

We are not responsible for and we do not endorse, support or guarantee the lawfulness, accuracy or reliability of any third party service or content displayed by or linked by the App. You acknowledge and agree that any reliance on or use of any third party service on or accessible from the App may be inaccurate and misleading and not representative of our views.
